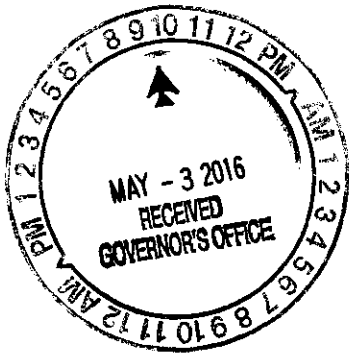

2 ENROLLED, An Act,

3 Relating to plumbing inspections; to amend Section  
4 22-26-2, Code of Alabama 1975; and to repeal Section 22-26-5,  
5 Code of Alabama 1975, to remove the requirement that certain  
6 plumbing inspections be done by the county boards of health.

7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

8 Section 1. Section 22-26-2, Code of Alabama 1975, is  
9 amended to read as follows:

10 "§22-26-2.

11 "The State Board of Health and/or county boards of  
12 health, acting through its duly authorized agents or  
13 employees, shall require every person, firm or corporation or  
14 municipal corporation, or agent thereof, owning or occupying  
15 property within the state, to install the ~~required plumbing~~  
16 ~~facilities~~, type and number of sewage collection, treatment,  
17 and disposal facilities conforming to rules and regulations of  
18 the State Board of Health and/or county boards of health and  
19 require connection to a sanitary sewer conforming to rules and  
20 regulations of the State Board of Health and/or county boards  
21 of health where sanitary sewers are available and are not  
22 regulated by the municipal corporation, or to dispose of  
23 sewage in such sanitary manner as shall be approved by the  
24 State Board of Health. All required sewage treatment and  
25 disposal facilities shall conform in every respect with the

1 specifications, rules, and regulations applying to these  
2 facilities made, adopted, and promulgated by the State Board  
3 of Health and/or county boards of health and shall be  
4 maintained as prescribed by the ~~said~~ rules and regulations. No  
5 rule or regulation of the State Board of Health shall require  
6 the permitting or inspection by county government of any  
7 plumbing within structures."

8 Section 2. Section 22-26-5, Code of Alabama 1975, is  
9 repealed.

10 Section 3. This act shall become effective  
11 immediately following its passage and approval by the  
12 Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.


