ENROLLED, An Act,

Relating to plumbing inspections; to amend Section 22-26-2, Code of Alabama 1975; and to repeal Section 22-26-5, Code of Alabama 1975, to remove the requirement that certain plumbing inspections be done by the county boards of health.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

Section 1. Section 22-26-2, Code of Alabama 1975, is amended to read as follows:

"§22-26-2.

"The State Board of Health and/or county boards of health, acting through its duly authorized agents or employees, shall require every person, firm or corporation or municipal corporation, or agent thereof, owning or occupying property within the state, to install the required plumbing facilities, type and number of sewage collection, treatment, and disposal facilities conforming to rules and regulations of the State Board of Health and/or county boards of health and require connection to a sanitary sewer conforming to rules and regulations of the State Board of Health and/or county boards of health where sanitary sewers are available and are not regulated by the municipal corporation, or to dispose of sewage in such sanitary manner as shall be approved by the State Board of Health. All required sewage treatment and disposal facilities shall conform in every respect with the
